



## Studio 180 Sampler Block of the Month

This is a graphic of the setting we will be using for a 10 month Sampler made with tools from Studio 180 Designs. It is a great opportunity to learn several traditional blocks using these wonderful tools. Each month's kit will include the fabric you need for making a portion of the quilt. During the year we will make blocks using the "Basics Tools". We will begin with the Tucker Trimmer in Feb., then add the Wing Clipper in April, add the Square<sup>2</sup> in June and the V Block Trimmer in Aug. If you don't already own the tools you will just need to add one every 2 months. At the end of the year you will be given 2 patterns to choose from for the center block. One will use the "Basics Tools" listed above, or you may choose a special medallion made with the Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star tool. **Choose from Black, White and Red - or - Neutral colorways.** See a sampling of fabric above.
